Guests will be billeted and expenses will be a bare minimum. Riders will need to be presentable at show level at all times as well as being available to talk to members of the general public and sponsors as required. Riders will be ambassadors for both Australia and the AMGA. Riders will be required to display appropriate behaviour at all times.
