Riders intending to represent Australia have been notified of the venue concerns discussed at IMGA rep meetings.  2026 hosting rights still to be discussed (Corne is the current allocated venue)  Nations Teams Championship  The United Nations team has been selected including coach and manager.		

	- The team will be made up of 2 New Zealand riders and 3 Australian riders. Team announcement is awaiting confirmation from our 3rd Aus rider. The coach is Danny Kopa and the team manager is Kylie Hall. (Kylie hasn't confirmed yet)  Discussion-  Angela- Said that USA is very frustrating. They are not responding to emails. Jemima also contacted them, but again no response.  Jemima will send an email to Michelle re this and what happens with scoring etc.  Angela would like to have a protocol to follow. 7. International Competitions	Worlds- Belgium is arranging a tent for some of the Under 18 team. They will have a parent with them. This can be a base for the U18s during the day. Profiles should have been sent.  Maureen gave a Uniform update- Polos and helmet covers ready. Sending to the riders leaving early. There has been a problem with Hurstbridge Saddlery sourcing enough green saddle cloths in time but we will have at least one per rider before they go with the first ones being done for those leaving early.

Angela has contacted Margaret re the height of horses. Some of our riders have horses over 15hh. Warwick is getting clearance for some of the gear that is not quite to specs.
