It is planned for the event to be held in Northam during early September culminating with the final day of competition being held at the Northam Farmers Show on the 15<sup>th</sup> of September.

Competitors, ponies, international and local supporters and officials will be based at the home of the Avon Valley Showjumping and Pony Club Grounds at Northam Equestrian Park.

AUSTRALIAN RIDERS WILL RIDE THEIR OWN PONIES.

INTERNATIONAL RIDERS CAN SELF SOURCE PONIES IF THEY WANT TO. ALL OTHER INTERNATIONAL RIDERS WILL GET PONIES FROM THE PONY POOL.

Entry Fees per rider are expected to be \$1000 AUD per rider.

Pony Hire fees including stabling/feeding etc are expected to be \$600 AUD per pony.

Pony stabling/feeding fees for Australian ponies are expected to be \$300 AUD per pony.

These grounds are located within the Town of Northam which is located approx. 86 km from Perth Airport which takes about 1.5 hours by car.

The grounds are a 5-10 minute drive from the center of Northam.

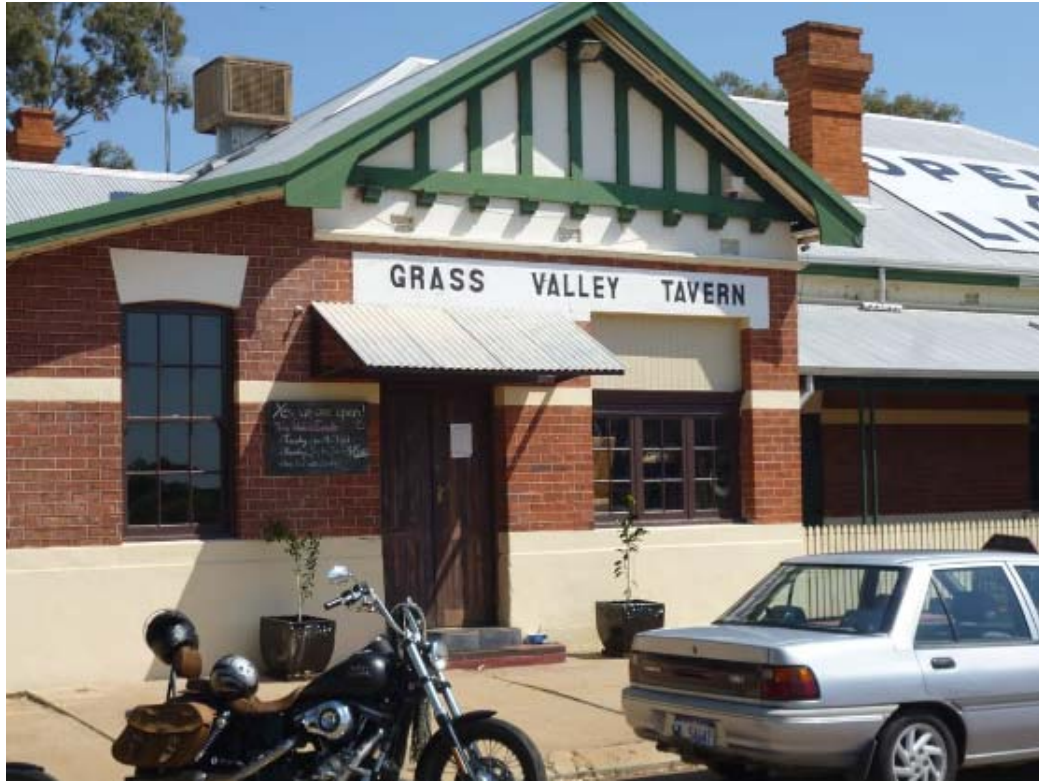
